DR. CLARK: This is a --

(inaudible) -- Allegany County Industrial
Development Agency project beneficiaries
NSF Burns Site 1, LLC. It's now seven
o'clock on May 25th at 220 -- 2023. We're
in the Town of Burns, Town Hall located at
Main Street in the Village of Canaseraga.

My name is Craig Clark and I'm the Executive Director to the Allegany County IDA in connection with the project, which is the subject of this public hearing.

Today I'm holding this public
hearing to allow citizens to make a
statement for the record relating to the
involvement of the Agency with a project.
The project for the benefit of NFS Burns
Site 1, LLC, a New York State Limited
Liability Company.

The proposed project consists of the following: The acquisition of interest in a portion of approximately 163.53 acres, consists -- comprised of two parcels of the land located at 1132 State Route 70

and County Route 13A in the Town of Burns in Allegany County, New York.

The construction of the land of a ground-mounted photovoltaic 5 megawatts solar energy facility includes panels, racking, inverters, electrical cables, battery storage, grid interconnection, site preparation, access road, and any other required improvements, and the acquisition of the installment therein of all the machinery. All fore baying -- foregoing to constitute a solar electric energy generated facility to be owned and operated by the company. granting of certain financial assistance within the meaning of Section 854 with respect to the foregoing including potential exemptions from certain sales tax and use taxes, real property taxes, real estate transfer taxes, and mortgage recording taxes.

I intend to provide general information on the Agency's general

authority and purpose to provide
assistance to the proposed project. I'll
then open the comment period to receive
any comments from all present, who would
wish to comment using the proposed project
or the financial assistance.

Our -- before discussing the general information and opening the hearing for public comments, I would like to first describe some details of the project.

The overall construction project is about an \$8.7 million project with the estimated cost of the proposed project as far as the IDA are equal to about \$418,117. And the estimated benefits being considered by the Agency are as follows: Sales tax exemption of 239,000, mortgage recording tax exemption to about 69,000.

The provision of Chapter 1030 of Laws of 1969 of New York Constitution
Title 1 of Article 18-A of the General
Municipal Law, Chapter 24 of the

Consolidated Laws of New York as amended in Chapter 99 in 1973 laws of the State of New York as amended and codified as Section 96 -- 906-a of said General Municipal Law, authorizing the Agency to promote, develop, encourage, and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, and equipping, and furnishing of manufacturing, warehousing, research, commercial, and industrial facilities among others.

The purpose of the meeting is pursuant to the Section 859-a reference of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York prior to the Agency providing any financial assistance in excess of \$100,000 to any project, the Agency among others, must hold a public hearing pursuant to Section 859-a of the Act with respect to said project. The proposed financial assistance to be provided by the Agency with respect to the proposed project may

exceed \$100,000, then prior to providing any financial assistance to the proposed project.

After consideration of the application received from the Company, the members of the Agency adopted a resolution on April 27th, 2023, about -- regarding this public hearing authorizing the Executive Director of the Agency to conduct the public hearing.

The Executive Director of the Agency caused notice of public hearing to be mailed May 12th, 2023, to the Chief Executive Officer of the Allegany County and published on May 14th, 223 -- 2023, in the "Spectator." Copies of the public hearing are available on the table here and unless there's an objection, I'm going to suggest waiving the full reading of that notice.

The comments received today at the public hearing will be presented on the -- to the members of the Agency at or

prior to the meeting for the members of the Agency will consider whether to approve the undertaking of the proposed project.

The notice of this public hearing indicated that any written comments could be addressed by -- to Craig R. Clark, Executive Director of the Agency and at this time no written comments have been received by the Agency prior to this hearing.

I will now open the public hearing at 7:05 and by the way of operating rules, if you wish to make a public comment, please let me know and raise your hand, and we'll typically record who is making the comments and give you three minutes or more depending on how many people are here.
